Shop There is a shop onsite selling fags, loo paper, toothpaste, midge spray, mobile-phone charging and other necessities from 07:00 til late.

Port Eliot Festival Wares The Official Merchandise Shop is next to the Haha bridge and outside the Round Room.

Shoes Please do not be surprised when you are asked to take off your shoes before attending any performances in the Round Room. The carpet was not purchased with festivals or mud in mind.

Swimming Pool Sorry – this is strictly off limits during the festival thanks to the Nanny State.

Church Service Festival goers are welcome to attend a service being held at 11:00 on 30th July. It is an ‘Open Communication Service’.

When You Go Please be sensitive to the residents of the village when you leave and remember to bag up your rubbish.

Get Off Our Land The site is open until lunchtime Monday August 1st for weekend ticket holders.

Taxis To get you to and from the site if you’re staying in the area, find local taxi firm numbers posted at the information points and production office in the Walled Garden.

Train Times East On Sunday the last trains to London leave at: 15:19, 16:19 and 17:52 On Monday morning they go at: 07:23, 08:32, 09:28, and 09:41.

Train Times West On Sunday the last trains to Penzance leave at: 17:52, 19:59 and 20:41. On Monday morning they go at 07:23, 08:40, 09:41 and 11:41.

First Aid is available 24 hours a day throughout the festival (see map). Anti-mosquito sprays etc, can be bought in the Site Shop.

Information Points There are two Information Points: one at the top and one at the bottom of the site - with large-scale maps to help you find your bearings. Festival staff will be on hand to answer any questions you might have. There are also two Campsite Information Points (see map at back), which are open all night.

Cash Machines Please refer to the map on the back page for their location.

Dogs Please do not bring a dog (guide dogs only).

Fires are not permitted unless raised off the ground in a firepan. We allow BBQ’s and camping stoves and advise you do not cook inside your tent under any circumstances.

Shower facilities are in the camping field at a cost of £2. Open 07:30 – 13:00 and 16:00 – 20:00. Please use sparingly. The Pamper Parlour is on hand with tea and coffee, mirrors and hairdryers to help you get festival glam.

Loowatt Experience Loowatt at Port Eliot with their premium posh loo service including; complimentary refresher massage; luxury hand soap and lotion; access to their chill out area. With the highest level of cleanliness and comfort you can experience in a field! Buy your wristband onsite for £33.

Queues We don’t like queues but when attending events in the Round Room and the Big Kitchen you will be asked to join one as space is limited. Please respect the people in front of you. It is unfair to join friends at the front of the queue as this will mean people behind you who thought they would be attending an event will have wasted their time. This is not cricket.

House Tours In order for the village of St Germans to benefit directly from the festival and as a thank you for all its support, Port Eliot House is open to festival-goers in aid of village charities on the Sunday of the festival from 12:00 – 16:00. Enter by conservatory.

Eco Cups We are battling single use plastic cup use this year by employing a reusable cup system at the bars. A one off fee of £1 is charged for your first cup, which covers the cost of manufacture. You can exchange it for a clean one every time you buy a drink, but cups are washed and reused rather than thrown away. When you’re finished you can keep the cup as a souvenir. Please help support us to keep the estate clean and green with this system. We are also encouraging you to bring a reuseable cup to reduce single use coffee cups which are not recyclable. You can purchase your own Festival cup from our Festival Shops or bring your own and use washing up stations at top and bottom of site.

Flower + Fodder Competitions held in the basement. Enter by the North Door. Saturday 11:00 – 20:00, Sunday 10:00 – 20:00.

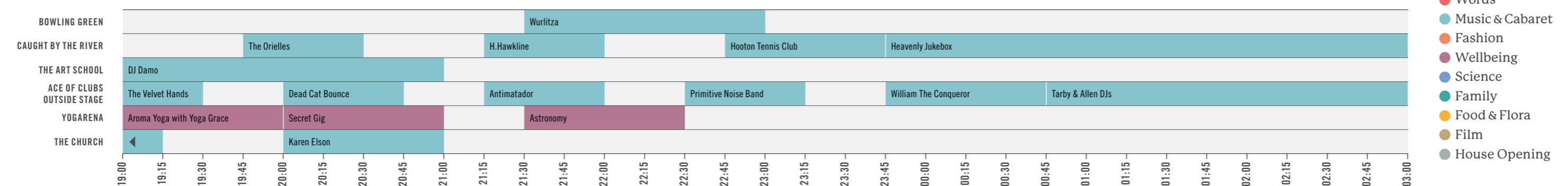
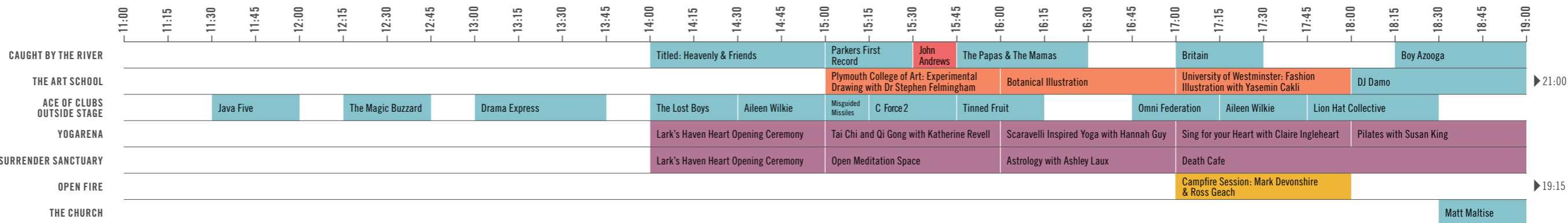
Water taps with mains water can be found in and around the site.

Alcohol You are permitted to bring your own alcohol to Port Eliot Festival but this is only to be consumed on the festival campsite. Please bring only a reasonable amount with you, i.e. a maximum of around 12 beers and a bottle of wine per person. For health and safety reasons, do not bring any glass bottles; decant into plastic before you arrive.

Litter is horrible! There are many bins around the site separately labelled recyclables and non-recyclables - please endeavour to use them. We aim to recycle 75% of all waste using local companies.

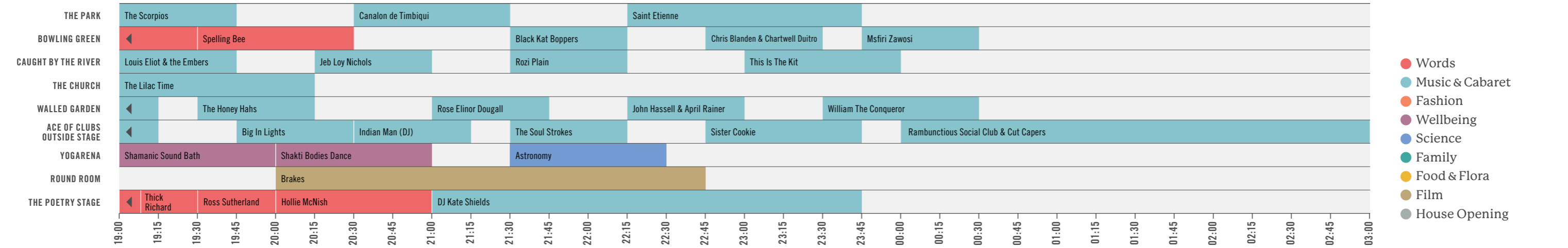
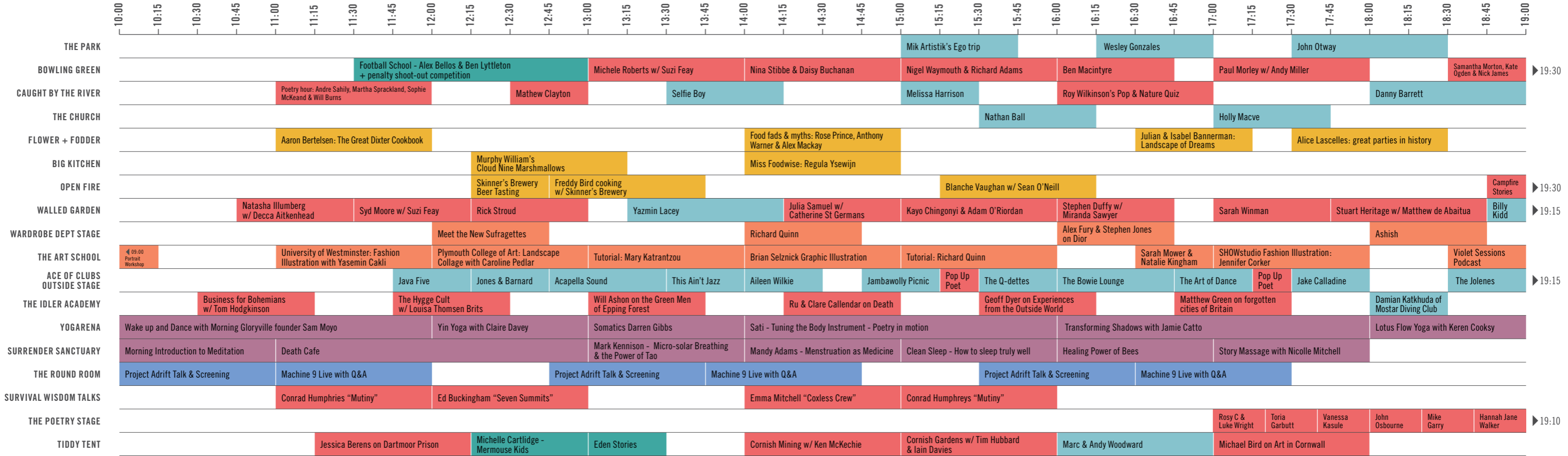
